### **SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES BETWEEN:**

NOVEMBER 30<sup>th</sup> and DECEMBER 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021

#### **1) Search Is On Scholarship - \$2,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2021)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently attending high school, college, vocational, or any other accredited post-secondary institution.
- B) Be 13 years of age or older and a legal resident of the 50 U.S. or D.C.

#### **2) Dell Scholars Program - \$20,000 - 300 Awards (Deadline: December 1, 2021)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be on track to graduate from an accredited high school in the current academic year.
- B) Demonstrate a need for financial assistance.

**4) Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarships - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 5, 2021)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in an accredited educational institution (kindergarten through graduate school) in the US.
- B) Have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services.

**5) Science Ambassador Scholarship - \$40,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 13, 2021)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior or an undergraduate student.
- B) Attend a school in the United States in the Fall of 2022.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a senior in high school.
- B) Have a cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent.
- C) Plan to enroll full-time, without interruption, for the entire 2022-23 academic year at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school.

**8) Path to Pro Scholarship Program - \$2,000 – 125 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2021)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior, high school graduate or have a GED equivalent.
- B) Plan to enroll, or be enrolled, in an approved trade-related program at an accredited two-year school (technical/vocational school or college) in the United States.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be under the age of 22.
- B) Be interested in designing and building things.

### **Social Change Fund United Scholarship**

**Due Date:** November 1, 2021

**Amount:** \$5,362

**Eligibility:** Open to Black students who are studying or plan to study mental health care, such as psychology, social work, or a similar field of study.

**Instructions:** Create an online account and share your utopian vision for optimal mental health in the Black community and explain how mental health care and advocacy can help achieve social justice for communities of color.

### **Answering Legal Law Scholarship**

**Due Date:** November 5, 2021

**Amount:** \$5,000

**Eligibility:** The student must currently be enrolled or accepted at an accredited law school as an incoming 1L. Must have a 3.5 GPA.

**Instructions:** Complete the online application and write a 500-1,000-word essay on one of the three given topics.

### **NCWIT Award for Aspirations in Computing**

**Due Date:** November 5, 2021

**Amount:** Varies

**Eligibility:** Students who are 13 years old and identify as a woman, genderqueer, or non-binary can apply. Students must attend a school in the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, or a U.S. overseas military base.

**Instructions:** Create an account and complete the online application.

### **Stop-Painting Scholarship**

**Due Date:** November 15, 2021

**Amount:** \$1,000

**Eligibility:** Any graduate student, graduate certificate, or executive education student enrolled at an accredited college, university, or related technical program may apply.

**Instructions:** Complete the online application, including a 750-word essay about how a visually organized workplace can make a company more efficient and productive. The essay must include at least one real-world example that you've observed, studied, or experienced academically or professionally.

### **The James Alan Cox Foundation for Student Photojournalists**

**Due Date:** November 15, 2021

**Amount:** High School students will receive a digital SLR camera.

**College/Technical students will receive \$2,500.**

**Graduate students will receive \$2,500.**

**Eligibility:** High school and college or technical students must be a sophomore or upperclassman at an accredited high school or postsecondary institution. Students should have taken at least one photography or related art class. Graduate students should be enrolled in a journalism or photojournalism program.

**Instructions:** Complete the online application form. High school applicants need to submit five still photographs that tell a story. Video awards are for college and graduate students only. College and graduate students need to submit two videos that tell a story. All applicants will need to include a 250-word essay about their interest in photography and photojournalism.

**Due Date:** November 17, 2021

**Amount:** \$1,000

**Eligibility:** Any female student who is a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident. The student must be a Public Relations, Communications, Media Studies, Marketing, or Journalism major with a desire to work in the entertainment or sports industry. Must be enrolled at a four-year accredited university, have a minimum 2.75 GPA, and demonstrate financial need.

**Instructions:** Complete the application and submit all required documents by email or traditional mail.

**Eligibility:** The student will need to be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate for the Fall 2022-Spring 2023 academic year at an accredited four-year or two-year institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories. Must demonstrate a need for financial support. One of the student's parents must be of Hispanic ancestry.
